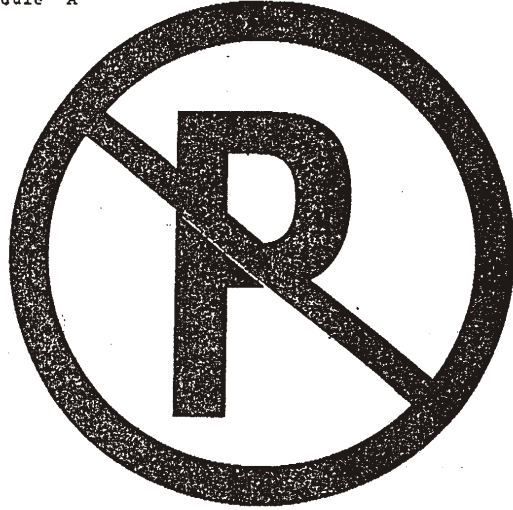


CHAPTER 165
BY-LAW RESPECTING PARKING PERMITS

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Bridgewater under the authority of Section 154 of the *Motor Vehicle Act*, R.S.N.S. 1989, c. 293, as amended, as follows:

1. This by-law shall be known as By-law Chapter 165 and may be cited as "The Parking Permit By-law".
2. In this by-law,
 - a) "parking signs" means any signs erected by the Traffic Authority prohibiting parking except by permit, said signs to be as shown in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law;
 - b) "person" includes a body corporate.
3.
 - a) Notwithstanding the provisions of the *Motor Vehicle Act* or any regulations made thereunder, any person in respect of which a parking permit is currently in force is exempt from parking prohibitions imposed by the parking signs as defined in Section 2(a) of this by-law;
 - b) A parking permit is not transferable;
 - c) A parking permit expires on the date of expiry as shown on the permit.
4. A parking permit may be issued to any person, upon application to the Bridgewater Town Centre Development Corporation or, upon the establishment of the Bridgewater Parking Commission, upon application to said Commission.
5. A parking permit shall be applicable only to the area identified on the parking permit.
6. The exemption from parking restrictions applies only where the parking permit is present in the vehicle so as to be clearly visible from the exterior.
7. It is an offence for any person to use or attempt to use another person's parking permit in order to gain an exemption pursuant to this by-law.
8. Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalty prescribed by the *Motor Vehicle Act* R.S.N.S. 1989 c. 293 as amended.
