

CHAPTER 149
CLOSING OF A PUBLIC STREET

1. THAT the Council do close to public use that portion of a street which is bounded and described in Schedule IIA11 hereto attached.
2. THAT the street as described in Section 1 of this by-law be closed and that all rights of public use heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the said Town may sell and convey the street or any portion thereof.

SCHEDULE " A "

All those lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being at Bridgewater, in the County of Lunenburg, and being lots BDC-3 and BDC-4, as shown on a plan of lands of the Bridgewater Development Commission made by Errol B. Hebb, N.S.L.S. #7 and dated the 28th day of October, 1987, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

LOT BDC-3: Bounded on the southeast by lands formerly of the Commission a distance of 467.33', on the southwest by a former 50' wide reserved street, on the northwest by lot BDC-2 and lot 13, and on the northeast by Porter Crescent containing 18,410 square feet more or less.

LOT BDC-4: Bounded on the southeast by lands of Carl H. Himmelman and Olive A. Himmelman, on the southwest by lot C, on the northwest by lot 62C, and on the northeast by other lands of the Bridgewater Development Commission.
