

CHAPTER 33
CLOSING OF A PUBLIC STREET

1. That the Council do close to public use that street known as Jubilee Road and Victoria Road in the Town of Bridgewater.
2. That the streets or portions thereof hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this By-law is as follows:

All that certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Bridgewater, in the County of Lunenburg in the Province of Nova Scotia, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Lot 1

Bounded on the southeast by the northwestern street line on Victoria Road as shown on the deed from Clyde S. Waterman to the Town of Bridgewater which boundary is shown as a broken line on a plan of survey showing property of Clyde S. Waterman in the Town of Bridgewater dated September 25, 1968 by Errol B. Hebb, N.S.L.S. #7;

Bounded on the northeast by lands formerly of the late Vernon Wile;

Bounded on the northwest and southwest by lands of Clyde S. Waterman;

Excepting and reserving to the Town of Bridgewater and the Public Service Commission of Bridgewater as easement for water and sewer pipe together with the right for their employees and agents to enter upon said lands and repair and replace the same from time to time.

Lot 2

Bounded on the southeast by the northwestern line of Jubilee Road as shown on the deed from Gwendolyn Sinclair to the Town of Bridgewater, which boundary is shown as a red line on a plan of survey showing proposed location of street limits for Jubilee Road, Bridgewater, Nova Scotia, and registered at the Registry of Deeds at Bridgewater, Nova Scotia, dated the 28th day of August 1964 by Neiff Joseph, N.S.L.S.#257;

Bounded on the northeast by lands of the Town Park of the Town of Bridgewater;

And bounded on the northwest and southwest by lands of Gwendolyn Sinclair.

3. That subject to the continuation of the rights of the Town of Bridgewater, and the Public Service Commission of Bridgewater to use, maintain and from time to time to replace water pipes and sewers on that portion of Victoria Road;

Then the portions of those streets, as described in Section 2 of this By-law, be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as streets in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the said Town may sell and convey the streets or any portions thereof.
