

CHAPTER 25

ANTI-NOISE BY-LAW

1. No person in the town of Bridgewater shall operate or cause to permit to be operated any public address system on any street unless such person holds a license therefore, which is in force.
2. The terms, conditions and hours of operation, as directed by this By-law, shall be set out in the license.
3. The fee for daily licenses shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00), and for monthly licenses, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). Such licenses may be granted by the Clerk of Licenses for the Town.
4. Except between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and nine o'clock in the afternoon on any afternoon on any week day, no such apparatus or device mentioned in Section 1 hereof shall be operated on any street in the said town.
5. Any license so granted may be cancelled or suspended by the Clerk of Licenses if the operation of the apparatus or device covered by the said license violates the terms or conditions attached to such licenses or unduly disturbs the peace and tranquility of the portion of the town in which the same is operated.

 - (1) No person shall use or operate a public address system, phonograph, gramophone, radio or other device or apparatus whether operated electronically, mechanically, or in any other way whatsoever, whether moveable or stationary which reproduce, amplify, emit or transmit sounds which are capable of being heard on any street or public place or in any buildings used wholly or part as a dwelling, other than the dwelling in which they are located.
 - (2) This section shall not apply to the use of operation of any public address on any street by a person who holds a license therefor, which is in force, and issued under this By-law.
7. Nothing herein contained shall apply to any horn, whistle, bell, or broadcasting device used by any Church or used for summoning or directing employees or used for public safety.
8. Any person in the town of Bridgewater who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall, upon conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days.
9. Chapter 25 of the By-laws of the Town entitled "Anti-Noise By-law" is hereby repealed.
