

**CHAPTER 18**  
**A BY-LAW RESPECTING "FIRE PROTECTION"**

1. This by-law shall be known as, and may be cited as, the Fire Protection By-law.
2. In this by-law "Town" means the Town of Bridgewater.
3. No burning shall be carried out within the Town save and except burning that is within a stove; furnace; or small fires in a properly constructed barbeque or grill for the purpose of cooking food. Properly constructed barbeque or grill shall consist of a stone, brick or building block construction with a chimney or flue including a spark arrester. These requirements do not govern gas fired or charcoal barbeques used for cooking food.
4. Chapter 18 of the by-laws of the Town of Bridgewater entitled "Fire Protection" dated January 11, 1991 is hereby repealed.
