

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CHAPTER 7</b> <b>OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES</b></p>
--

1. Any person may be appointed to more than one office, the duties of which are not inconsistent with each other.
2. Any officer appointed by the Council shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, take and subscribe an oath that he will faithfully perform the duties of his office to the best of his ability, which oath shall be administered by the Mayor, Stipendiary Magistrate, Councillor or a Commissioner of the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia.
3. Every such officer shall take and subscribe such oath within one week of his being notified of his appointment.
4. Any person may be dismissed from office at any time on failure to perform properly and efficiently the duties of his office.
5. Every officer shall receive such remuneration as is determined by resolution of the Council.
6. Every officer dismissed by the Council, unless removed because of failure to perform any of the duties of his office, shall receive remuneration pro rata for the time served.
7. The former Chapter 7 of the by-laws of the Town is hereby repealed and this by-law substituted therefore.
