

**CHAPTER 3
TOWN SEAL**

1. The Seal, circular in form, with the outline of the existing bridge across the LaHave River, as a device surrounded by the words "Town of Bridgewater, N.S Incorporated February 13, 1899", shall be the common Seal of the Town.
2. The Seal shall be kept by the Town Clerk.
3. It shall be used when authorized by any statute or by any by-law of the Town, or by direction or resolution of the Council.
4. It shall be affixed to every agreement, contract, deed, lease or other document, to which the Town is a party, and which, in order to bind the Town required to be authenticated by a Seal.
5. The Mayor or Town Clerk shall affix the Seal to every agreement, contract, deed, lease or other document, which shall also be signed by the Mayor and Clerk; provided, however, that the Clerk or Deputy Clerk may sign the Tax Certificate of the Town and affix the Town Seal thereto.
6. The following form may be used when any document is to be so authenticated: -

7. The Clerk may sign and affix the Seal to any certified copies of the by-law or resolutions adopted by Council, or other extracts from the minutes of the Town Council.
8. Any person requiring the Town Seal to be affixed to any certificate or document shall pay to the Town the fee of \$5.00.
9. The former Chapter 3 of the by-laws of the Town is hereby repealed and this by-law substituted therefore.
